Completion of this worksheet and documentation does not constitute agreement to provide GRP funding. The original screening worksheet should be filed with the applicant case file or GRP file and the screening priority (High, Medium, and Low) shall be recorded. ONLY HIGH PRIORITY EASEMENT APPLICATIONS WILL BE RANKED FOR FUNDING.
