

Access Control (472) Requirements

2012 EQIP & WHIP

Eligible lands: Private agricultural land, previously grazed pasture fields, and previously grazed marsh or lowland areas where a fence is needed for access control to protect, promote, and enhance natural resources.

Eligible Lands for Access Control are:

- Previously grazed pasture areas
- Previously grazed marsh or low land areas

Access Control Practice Requirements:

1. To be eligible for receiving payment, livestock must be present on the offered acres, and access control through fencing must be used to exclude the livestock from the acreage, or sensitive areas.
2. The fence installed to provide access control must meet or exceed the TN FOTG standard for Fencing (code 382).

Income must be foregone to be eligible for this practice and it *must be planned in conjunction with Fence (382) installation.*

Definition of Foregone Income:

Forgone Income: Includes lost income from a change in land use or land taken out of production or the opportunity cost of accepting less farm income in exchange for improved resource conditions.
